In compliance with Government Code 6253 this letter addresses your California Public Records Act request that is dated August 25, 2020. This letter constitutes our formal response to your public record demand.

You are requesting the records of cases for "any individual sentenced to 187(a) between the years of 1991 to 2020 that include the following data:

- 1. Case numbers
- 2. Charging date
- Disposition date
- 4. Final disposition summary (Plead guilty, found guilty)
- 5. Deputy District Attorney's name
- 6. All sentencing penal codes for each case (eg. 187(a), 190.2(a)(3)
- 7. Any demographic information available including:
 - Race of defendant
 - 2. Gender of defendant.
 - 3. Age at the time of sentencing"

We are interpreting your request to be for records of cases for defendants sentenced pursuant to convictions for Penal Code section 187(a) between the years of 1991 to 2020.

We have responsive records to your request that are disclosed with this response. These records were obtained from our Case Management System which is derived from data provided to and input by employees of this office and therefore may contain human errors. Additionally, our Case Management System was converted from our previous case management system in 2003; this process did result in several data conversion errors. Finally, some cases on the disclosed records have not yet been sentenced resulting in missing age at sentence.
